### INFORMATION FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

#### APPLICATION

International Students applications to all Faculties and Vocational Schools will be accepted from 24 August 2020 to 10 September 2020.

Candidates can apply if they meet the criteria published by the Council of Higher Education (YÖK) and accepted by the University.

#### RECOGNISED EXAMS FOR THE APPLICATION

Exam results from any of the following:

- International Student Exam (YOS) conducted by a Turkish state University,
- Internationally and nationally accredited High Schools (Abitur, International Baccalaureate, GCE, Tawjihi etc.) and/or
- University Entrance Exams (TQDK, SAT, ACT, GAOKO etc.)

will be accepted.

- Candidates who hold results from different exams can apply with the exam result of their preference.

Amongst the exam results that can be used in the application process:

- there is no time-wise limitation on the validity period of High School Graduation exam / High School Diplomas.

However, the validity period of:

- the International Student Exam (YOS)
- the exams that have the status of University Entrance is limited to two (2) years.

(Only for 2020 – 2021 Academic Year, candidates, with results from University entrance (GRE, GMAT, SAT etc.) exams, can also apply if their result notice document is within 2 years of its expiry date.

2.	<p><b>REQUIRED DOCUMENTS FOR APPLICATION</b></p> <p><b>1- Passport: The page showing your personal identifying information</b></p> <p><b>2- For Blue Card Holders: A certified copy of the card</b></p> <p><b>3- High School Diploma: An original copy and its translation in Turkish, both approved by either a Notary or a Turkish Foreign Representatives</b></p> <p><b>4- Copy of your Transcript: Transcript must show; the courses taken, course grades, and Grade Point Average (GPA) which is approved by the High School Directorate</b></p> <p><b>5- Copy of your Exam Score: An official document showing your exam score; this document provides an evidence that you have taken an exam which is required for university admission. Recognised exams are mentioned on the first page of this document.</b></p> <p><b>6- Photo: A passport-sized photo must be in colour, against a white, grey, or soft coloured background, with appearance of shoulders and head. The photo must have been taken within the last 6 months.</b></p>
3.	<p>Candidates must submit only one application form. Submitting more than one application forms will be deemed as invalid, and the application will be automatically withdrawn.</p>
4.	<p>Notices:</p> <p>Candidates are fully responsible for the accuracy of the information provided on the application form.</p> <p>Candidates must provide their full names as written on their passport.</p>

## EVALUATION OF APPLICATIONS

1.	Candidates may choose to apply up to four programs that are given a quota.
2.	A- priority in the evaluation will be given to a candidate who has taken a YOS exam, and other university admission exams such as TQDK, SAT, ACT, GAOKO, and etc. which are held in candidate's home country. B-After the first-round placement (according to the evaluation criteria 2.A mentioned above), in the case of remaining quota in the program, these will be allocated based on candidates' high school graduation GPA.
3.	Candidates will be admitted to one program only considering their program preference order.
